We want to improve community connectedness and inclusivity. We want to build relationships between the school and wider community.

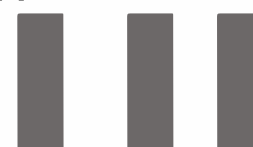


Measures of success:
